- They're going to go to a very expensive restmurant.
- I'm going to come home late.

NEGATIVE FORM

SUBJECT	VERB TO BE + NOT	GOING TO	INFINITIVE
I	Am not	Going to	Clean
He/she/it	Is not (isn't)		Cool
We/you/they	Are not (aren't)		Travel

- I'm not going to go to the party
- Just isn't going to work today
- They aren't going to stay it that hotel

QUESTION FORM

Question word	Verb to be	Subject	Going to	Infinitive
What	Am not	I	Going to	Do
Were	Is not (isn't not)	He/she/it		Go
.....	Are not (aren't)	We/you/they		Travel

Ejemplos

- What are you going to do later?
- What is she going to cook?
- Are they going to attend the meeting?
